Who are we looking for?

We are seeking a highly motivated, experienced ecologist to join our ecology team. We are particularly interested in candidates who have an interest in business development as we look to strengthen our services

Role and Requirements

You will actively manage a wide range of field surveys. You will have good botanical skills and experience of biodiversity net gain. Having a protected species licence would also be advantageous.

You will be managing your own survey schedule and should be able to independently organise your time. You will work with TEP's established ecology team based in Warrington and across the UK and will be responsible for monitoring the financial performance of your designated projects.

The successful candidate must be able to demonstrate:

- excellent management skills, overseeing a busy and varied workload, supervising field staff and coordinating project work with other professionals;
- attention to detail and accuracy, particularly in respect of quality assurance, delivery of contracts on time and within budget;
- high levels of written and verbal communication; and
- experience of attending meetings with clients and design teams at a senior level.



Qualifications

- Have a degree or equivalent in a relevant ecology discipline
- We are interested to hear from applicants who are Chartered or who are eligible for Associate or Full membership of the Chartered Institute of Ecology and Environmental Management (CIEEM).

Experience

- Have proven experience scoping, designing, pricing and delivering ecologically complex schemes
- Experience producing a range of written assessments including desk based studies, technical reports, Preliminary Ecological Assessments and Ecological Impact Assessment.
- Experience authoring ecology chapter of Environmental Statements and/or HRAs is desirable
- Can demonstrate experience of project management skills and experience of providing consistent, professional advice with an ability to communicate effectively and work collaboratively with colleagues, clients, planners and consulting with regulators.
- Can demonstrate experience of leading extended Phase 1 habitat and a range of protected species surveys.
- Experience in Biodiversity Net Gain including using Metric 3.1 and developing habitat management strategies is desirable.
- Experience undertaking higher level botanical surveys such as NVC, hedgerow, or UK Hab is desirable
- Holds a protected species licence, and experience of designing and delivering licenced mitigation schemes is desirable but not essential.
