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The Opportunity

Who are we looking for?

We are seeking highly motivated, experienced ecologists over a range of grades to join the TEP Ecology Team in our Warrington office. This opportunity will appeal to ecologists with at least 3 years experience, looking for a consultant, senior or principal role and we are particularly interested in candidates who have technical skills in at least one of the following: botany/habitat surveying; biodiversity net gain; bat ecology (Level 2 bat licence holder); and ornithology.

You will work with a broad range of clients and development sectors across the UK which includes residential, urban regeneration, utilities infrastructure, commercial and leisure developments as well as projects associated with BNG off-site delivery, green infrastructure, conservation and restoration schemes and strategic level projects.

We are a close-knit team and as a member of our 40+ in-house ecology team you will be supported by your co-workers and our network of trusted sub consultants and will share in our strong ethos of knowledge sharing and professional development.

The role is suitable for office or 'hybrid working' with time split between home and office working. You will also be expected to travel from time to time, including staying overnight at different locations, to meet the requirements of projects.

Role and Requirements

You will lead on and contribute to a wide range of projects, making use of your field survey, assessment and reporting skills and your knowledge of current best practice and the planning system. You will be responsible for ensuring the advice and recommendations resulting from survey and assessment work are communicated effectively to clients through written reports and verbal communication. You will be proactive in your approach to help our clients navigate the planning and licensing processes.

You will have excellent project management skills and be able to organise your time effectively in order to ensure timely delivery or project tasks. You will be responsible for monitoring the financial performance of your designated projects. You will also lead on and contribute to the production of fee proposals for our work.

- attention to detail and accuracy, particularly in respect of quality assurance, delivery of contracts on time and within budget;

Experience

- Have proven experience scoping, designing, pricing and delivering on a range of ecological schemes in a development/ planning setting
- Can demonstrate experience of leading extended Phase 1 habitat and a range of protected species surveys
- Have FISC Level 4 or above and proven experience of higher level botanical surveys such as NVC, hedgerow, UKHab and BNG habitat condition assessment is desirable
- Demonstrable experience in Biodiversity Net Gain assessment including use of the Metric and developing habitat enhancement, creation and management strategies is desirable
- Holds a protected species licence (particularly a Level 2 bat licence), and has experience of designing and delivering licenced mitigation schemes is desirable for Senior and Principal positions.
- Experience producing a range of written assessments including desk based studies, technical reports, Preliminary Ecological Assessments and Ecological Impact Assessment
- Experience authoring ecology chapters of Environmental Statements and/or HRAs is desirable for Principal positions
- Can demonstrate experience of project management skills and experience of providing consistent, professional advice with an ability to communicate effectively and work collaboratively with colleagues, clients, planners and consulting with regulators.
