Access Strategy

Key Principles

The proposal aims to promote sustainable modes of transport for pick-up and drop-off. Key principles include:

- Vehicular access via a new two-way access from Isaacs Lane.
- Staff car park provided with 54 spaces (includes staff, visitor and accessible parking).
- Pedestrian entrances have been located to the north, east and west of the school to ease pressure on drop off and pick up areas and provide the school with flexibility during these busier times.
- Off-site drop off parking has been provided at various locations with direct pedestrian crossing points for parents and pupils. All drop off/dual use spaces are within a two-minute walk.
